WA PRIMARY SCHOOLS MASSED CHOIR FESTIVAL 2017

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

The Senior Choir will be performing at the 'WA Primary Schools Massed Choir Festival' at Perth Concert Hall on **Wednesday 20 September 2017.**

Note: As members of the Senior Choir ALL CHILDREN are expected to participate in this prestigious event showcasing the excellence of music in our primary schools.

♪ REHEARSAL 1 – Friday 11 August 2017

Churchlands Senior High School 9.30am-11.30am

The choir will attend a 'Cluster Workshop' with other participating schools. The bus will leave school at 8.30am. Students will need to bring a sealed water bottle and morning tea in a disposable container clearly marked with your child's name. (No food is to be taken on stage – water bottles only). The choir will eat lunch on returning to school. All students MUST be in full school uniform.

♪ REHEARSAL 2 – Tuesday 19 September 2017

Perth Concert Hall, 9.45am-1.00pm

This will be a rehearsal as a full massed choir. The bus will leave school at 8.45am. Students will need to bring a sealed water bottle and morning tea in a disposable container clearly marked with your child's name. (No food is to be taken on stage – water bottles only). The choir will eat lunch on returning to school. All students MUST be in full school uniform.

♪ PRE-CONCERT REHEARSAL AND CONCERT – Wednesday 20 September 2017

Perth Concert Hall, Rehearsal 6.15pm-7.00pm Concert 7.30pm-9.00pm

- All students will travel to the venue by bus. Students will need to be at school at 5.00pm for a 5.15pm departure.
- Students are to wear full music uniform :
 - ♪ Girls – School Jazz Pants (available from the uniform shop)
 - ♪ Boys – School Cargo Pants (available from the uniform shop)
 - ♪ Music Polo Shirt (provided by the school)
 - ♪ FLAT Black shoes and black socks
 - ♪ School jumper or jacket
- Hair Requirements :
 - ♪ All hair past shoulders needs to be pulled back in one ponytail or braid
 - ♪ No 'stray bits'
 - ♪ Ribbon or scrunchy to match school colours is permitted
- No food to be brought to the concert. Water bottles are permitted.
- Students to eat their evening meal before departing on the bus trip for the final rehearsal and concert.
- Under no circumstances are mobile phones, iPods or other electronic devices permitted. These will be removed and returned at the end of the night.
- **All students are to be collected by parents after the performance** by 9.15pm from the Perth Concert Hall. Parents will not be permitted backstage.

NO NUT products are to be brought to any of the rehearsals.

The cost to parents will be \$15.00 which covers bus transport to Rehearsals 1 & 2. The school will meet bus costs for the Pre-concert Rehearsal and Concert.
