Dear Parents / Guardians,

This year, our MAC Class has been accepted to participate, along with 19 other schools across the state, in the Western Power Circuit Breakers program for students in Years 4-6. This program is designed to develop students' knowledge and skills with a focus on electrical engineering, using 3D printers. On successful completion of all aspects of the program, our school will be eligible to keep both 3D printers which we have been allocated for the duration of this project, and integrate them into our learning environment.

The Circuit Breakers program will assist our students to continue to be thinkers, makers and innovators in their learning. The program focuses on examining a variety of aspects of the Western Power network through a total of six lessons, exploring what it takes to provide electricity to our community that is safe and reliable, as well as exploring new technologies, changing the way we look at electricity supply in the future. During these lessons, students will also work directly with a Western Power Engineer to explore these concepts, ask questions and extend their thinking. They will explore 3D printing, with teacher supervision.

Equipped with this new knowledge, our class will be challenged with a specialised project, based around the development of the future of our electricity network. Working to complete this project, students will be asked to look at the world around them differently, and find ways to bring their ideas for a future network to life, using a 3D printer. The project will culminate in an interschool, Western Power Science Fair to be held on 25 October 2018, where students will present their ideas and findings to peers and invited guests. More information on the Science Fair will be provided later in Term 3 or early in Term 4.
