Kalamunda History Village Excursion

During this term, our Year 2 students have been learning about Australian History and how life used to be over 100 years ago. We have planned an excursion based around this topic to the Kalamunda History Village, where we will participate in activities that teach us about early Pioneer life in the hills of Perth. Students will specifically be experiencing school life, life in a settler's cottage without water or electricity, laundry tasks, chores in a carriage shed, the orchard shed and playing old fashioned games.
