



Dear Parents and Guardians,

This term in Science, our class is exploring life cycles and interactions of living things. In this unit we would like to learn about seeds that are in our environment and use them in an investigation of seed dispersal.

We are asking students and families if they can look for seeds in and around the home. These may be in fruits or vegetables that are eaten or seeds found in the garden. Students are asked to collect a number of each seed (dried) and place in a small plastic bag. Please write the name of the seed or fruit on the bag. Alternatively, students can take a photo or draw the fruit that the seed came from and attach to the plastic bag with the date of collection.

Students will be asked to share their collected seeds with the class in week 8.
